With the intention of regrouping its various services, the federal government is building Campus UVEK on industrial wasteland bordered by a river and a protected forest.

The two new buildings for the Federal Roads Authority, of up to seven storeys above ground, are built with a mixed wood and concrete structure, which enables a reduction in the grey energy required for its construction. The 990 work stations are modular and can be laid out as individual or open-plan offices. The central atrium provides natural overhead light and multiple viewpoints between the interior and the exterior. The environmental targets are high (Eco bau, LowEx, SNBS 5).
