ITU HEADQUARTERS IN GENEVA

The International Telecommunications Union has been present for 55 years in the international organizations' district in Geneva. Its new headquarters will house 720 workstations and a set of meeting and conference rooms. The building reflects the trapezoidal shape of the site. It comprises a solid podium, which accommodates the meeting spaces, which in turn is topped by glazed office floors organized around a courtyard. The play of transparencies promotes the internal relationships between work spaces and the perception of the life of the building from the outside. A thorough study was undertaken to optimize the building's form and achieve the construction cost target.
