



CHUV, TRANSFORMATION OF THE OPERATING THEATRES

The central operating department of the CHUV is the nerve center of the intensive-care hospital. Commissioned in 1982, the 4,000 m² area regroups all surgical specialties. The complete transformation of the 18 operating theatres and recovery rooms in the department provides a new facility which is flexible and adaptable. With increased storage capacity, it is adapted to current medical, technical and security procedures. After studying various options, it was decided to build a two-level modular department with 16 theatres on the roof, connected to the existing building by an extension of the vertical circulation networks and footbridges. The two successive projects, each carried out in a single stage, limit the impact on existing building operations. In the long term, the modular block will be maintained for technical intervention platforms.
