



AQUATIS AND VENNES P+R IN LAUSANNE

As part of the m2 metro development, the City of Lausanne built a 1,200-space P+R multi-story car park directly accessible from the motorway exit and connected to the M2 Vennes metro station. The development of a mixed use building on the parking facility was subject to a Public Private Partnership procurement procedure and the car park was subject to a tender procedure for a total professional services contract.

The Aquatis project unites a freshwater aquarium, exhibiting the ecosystems of Europe and the five continents, and a 140-room 3-star hotel with restaurant, spa and conference centre.
