VEILLON DISTRICT IN BUSSIGNY

The former Veillon industrial site will accommodate a neighbourhood of 2,000 inhabitants and jobs, all connected to the new public transport node in western Lausanne comprising tram, trambus, and motorway access. The objective is to create, in three phases with four architectural practices, a dense, wooded, user-friendly complex, oriented towards sustainable transport, bringing together commercial activities, a hotel, offices, an urban farm and 600 housing units. A protective screen wall runs the entire length of the district facing the motorway. The environmental standards meet the SNBS OR criteria.
