The Campus de la Paix is a network of buildings of the graduate institute of international and development studies (IHEID) which lies along a pedestrian route from Place des Nations to the banks of Lake Geneva. The Maison de la Paix is the result of a process that combined the library and the teaching areas of UHEI and IUED and of the need for premises for three centers devoted to the civil promotion of peace.

An international 2-round design competition was launched to find the best architectural solution to accommodate this complex project on an elongated, triangular-shaped plot alongside the railway hub.
