## SECONDARY SCHOOL LEMAN IN APPLES

In order to cope with the strong growth of their population, twelve municipalities at the foot of the Jura joined forces to extend the secondary school in Apples.

The L-shaped building marks the entrance to the village between the agricultural zone and the orchards. It houses the classrooms and special-purpose areas, a multi-purpose sports hall and the municipal council hall. The large volume under a single roof and the copper cladding are reminiscent of farmhouses in the Vaud region. Inside, the large windows provide both a sense of intimacy and a panoramic view of Lake Geneva.
