



CHEMIN DE NORMANDIE BUILDING IN GENEVA

The Winterthur Assurances' administrative building was built in 1975 by the architect Jean-Marc Lamunière. Following studies of numerous variants, the rigorous modular typology of the construction made it possible to envisage its transformation into a residential block of 105 dwellings, all the while respecting its historic character. An extension of 50 dwellings is planned, with a common podium reserved for commercial and service activities. The architectural expression of the new construction extends the horizontal lines of the historic building, without repeating its vertical rhythm.
