MEDICAL-SOCIAL FACILITY IN YVERDON-LES-BAINS

The project involves the construction of a 56-bed medical-social facility for psychogeriatric patients, a professional kitchen serving other establishments in the region and administrative premises for the Saphir Foundation.

The existing manor house, which is noted as class 2 in the construction heritage inventory, is preserved and extended by the striped down lines of the new residential building and by a large protected garden. The large windows offer sweeping views over the city of Yverdon-les-Bains, lake Neuchâtel, and the Jura.
