## HOME SALEM MEDICAL-SOCIAL FACILITY IN ST-LEGIER

In the immediate vicinity of the village center, the project involves the transformation and extension of the existing medical-social facility with 45 additional beds for geriatric and psychogeriatric purposes, a temporary respite centre and a multipurpose hall. Two new buildings accommodate three living units, the rooms of which offer an unobstructed view of the landscape. The communal areas on the ground floor overlook a secure garden. The project will be completed while maintaining existing operations. The building meets the criteria for the Minergie-P-ECO standard.
