Headquarters of the International Cycling Union, the project houses the management, administrative services and high-level training center for the three Olympic disciplines: road, track and BMX. The wooden velodrome is the centerpiece, with a 200 m track and terraced seating for 700 spectators. It is covered by a three-dimensional structure and a translucent pneumatic membrane. The project was carried out as part of a total professional services mandate with a cost guarantee.
