THE JUNCTION ECOQUARTIER IN GENEVA

Six proprietors joined forces to develop the Ecoquartier Junction project through a design competition and participatory process on the former site of a utility services company along the edge of the Rhone. The program includes 312 residential units, large floor areas assigned to artisanal and commercial uses, storage depots for museums, an underground carpark and open public spaces. The project focuses on quality of life and positive interaction between residents with a view to creating a sustainable development with energy efficient construction, renewable heat production, rooftop vegetable gardens and priority given to pedestrians and bicycles.
