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GARE-DES-EAUX-VIVES DISTRICT IN GENEVA

The Gare-Des-Eaux-Vives district is near the city centre, with excellent public transport connections and local public services. It represents a significant centre for urban development. The aim is to develop cultural and sports activities and facilities, as well as a major public transport hub around the main left bank railway station of the Léman Express line.

Two large complexes will be built facing each other on opposite sides of a linear public space. The project is multifaceted with a wide range of functions: 240 residential units, sports and leisure facilities, commercial areas and an underground car park.
