LAVIGNY INSTITUTE

The Lavigny institute supports and promotes the well-being and fulfilment of people with disabilities in a comprehensive manner.

The three new pavilions accommodate 72 residents on one level. The spaces are bright, differentiated by a variation of colors, with significant outside areas. The structure is made of reinforced concrete and the facades of prefabricated wooden panels. The winning project was redesigned several times to comply with a design-to-cost approach. The building meets the criteria for the Minergie-Eco label.
