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EDV ADMINISTRATIVE CENTER IN GENEVA

The Swiss federal clearing facility decided to group together 950 work places at Rue Edmond-Vaucher by refurbishing and extending the administrative center built in 1978.

The new wing is directly connected to the existing building thus creating a well-integrated ensemble. The cornice of the old facade is extended in a contemporary architectural language. The existing building was maintained in continuous use during the construction works. Care was taken to ensure the preservation of building occupant flows and all existing technical services. The construction phases were studied and stipulated in detail in the tender documentation. The building meets the standards required for the Minergie label.
