LA TUILIERE FOOTBALL STADIUM IN LAUSANNE

Within the Metamorphosis urban development project, the city of Lausanne plans to erect a sports complex on the Blécherette plateau with a new football stadium as its showpiece.

The stadium is characterized by its four elevated corners which form a monumental entrance for 12,000 spectators. Great care was taken to ensure the functionality and security of the sporting facilities, in addition to minimizing the impact of light and noise pollution on neighbouring dwellings. The construction's environmental impact has been reduced through the optimization of earth movements during the construction phase combined with a strategy for energy efficient operation upon completion. By analyzing different variants of the project brief a balance was found between the client's quality and financial requirements.
