MAINTENANCE CENTER FOR A MOTORWAY

The A16 Transjurane motorway was officially commissioned in 2016. The maintenance center was built at Loveresse. Under a single roof, the large 150m by 30m volume houses garages, workshops, the protected salt storage facility and administrative services. Wood was exclusively used for the structure of the building and the plant-covered roof which overhangs the facades. The heated parts of this industrial building meet the standards required for the Minergie-P-ECO label. In 2018, the Transjurane maintenance center received a Lignum award for its exemplary use of wood in its construction.
