ECO-NEIGHBORHOOD AT GRANGE IN CORSIER

The municipality of Corsier/Geneva wished to control the development of a new neighborhood in order to establish a link between the historical village center and more recent constructions along Route de Thonon.

Around forty housing units in four groups of buildings are arranged around a central square which is reminiscent of the courtyard principle in a village farm. The challenge of the project was to create a setting that promotes social interaction whilst simultaneously respecting domestic privacy. Multiple variants of the project were tested in order to develop the project brief in accordance with the financial constraints of the client. The buildings meet very high requirements with respect to energy performance (THPE).
